Arab Board Exam Registration and Requirements

1. Exam registration (Part 1 written, final written and clinical OSCE exam)

- 1. Fill out the Arab board exam application approved by Program Director.
- 2. One photograph (placed on the application form).
- 3. Copy of the USD 300 payment receipt (including the exam name and date).
- 4. Fill out the resident transcript signed by the Program Director (Please use the updated template with Dubai health logo).
- 5. Valid passport copy.
- 6. Activation of institutional email [click here].
- 7. Additional requirement per specialty, please refer to Arab Board website.
- 8. If you don't submit the application or an apology, the exam will be counted as a trial.
- 9. All documents should be combined into one PDF file and compressed to a minimum size and sent prior to deadline.

2. Research and Logbook of Academic Activities:

- Research and logbook are required for exam registration. The following programs need research as a requirement (General Surgery, Obstetrics & Gynecology, Pediatrics and Dermatology).

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National Institute for Health Specialties (NIHS) Exam Registration and Requirements

1. National Institute for Health Specialties (NIHS) – Emirati Board Exam Registration and

Requirements:

Note: Registered candidates will undergo a verification process based on the updated resident information provided by their program. Once a trainee's profile is approved, they will be notified about the exam dates via the webpage. Upon approval, candidates will be informed that they can enroll for the exam when it opens.

2. NIHS Exam Registration and Exam Eligibility:

- 1- Details regarding the Part 1 & Final Written exams have been announced on the Emirati Registration Webpage <u>Click here</u>
 - a. Eligible residents are invited to register through the following link: <u>Click here</u>
 ((Emirati Board Examination Part 1 requires a minimum of 9 months of training onward))
 - b. The registration process:
 - 1. Payment of an annual fees of payment of 1,000 AED (excluding tax) is required.
 - 2. Registered candidates will undergo a verification process based on the updated resident information provided by their program.

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- 3. Once a trainee's profile is approved, they will be notified about the exam dates via the webpage. Upon approval, candidates will be informed that they can enroll for the exam when it opens.
- 4. Additionally, a fee of 3,000 AED (excluding tax) will be charged for each Part 1, Final Written, and Comprehensive Clinical Examination (CCE).

2- Required documents for registration include:

- a. Personal photo
- **b.** Educational Diploma (Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery certificate)
- c. Passport
- d. Emirates ID
- e. Medical License
- f. Letter of Eligibility signed by the program director

3- Other required documents:

- a. Registration in the <u>Final Written exam</u>: EPAs and a Final Examination Eligibility Letter signed by the Program Director.
- **b.** Comprehensive Clinical Examination (CCE): list of rotations & certificate of completion of training signed by the DIO.

4- Results:

- Residents will be able to access their results through their profile on the Emirati Board Examination webpage. They will also receive an email notification about the results' announcement.
- Furthermore, results will be sent to the program director, maintaining confidentiality for educational purposes.
- 5- Exam Trials: Candidates are allowed three attempts for the Written Examinations
- **6- Appeal:** For those wishing to appeal their Written Exam results, a re-monitoring request can be made within one week of the result's issuance through this link: Click here

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
