

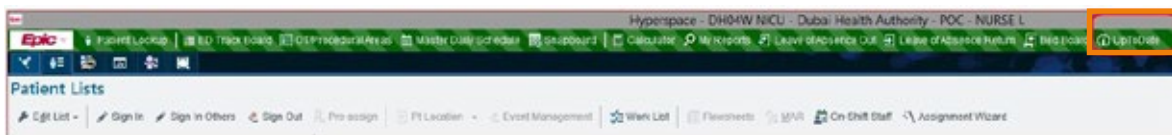

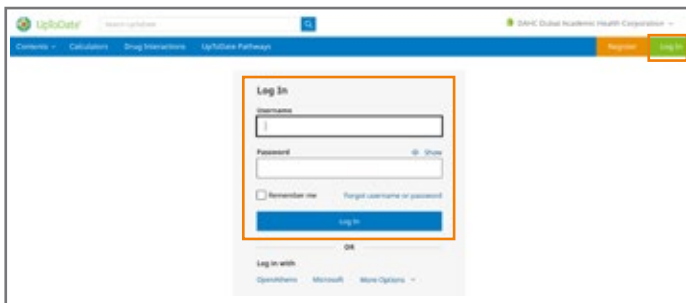
How to Access UpToDate via Salama

To set up a proper automatic login to UpToDate from Salama, follow these instructions. After completing the instructions here, clicking the Salama UpToDate link will display your accrued CPD and instantly log you into UpToDate with your name.

- 1 Click on Salama UpToDate link within the EMR (see appendix for a list of screens)



- 2 The first time you log-in to UpToDate from Salama you will be brought to the DAHC UpToDate Homepage.

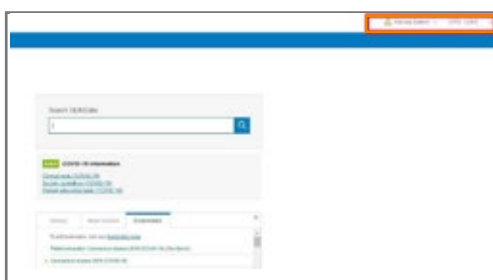


- 3 Login using your UpToDate credentials

- 4 If you do not have existing login credentials, click the Register button to create an account.

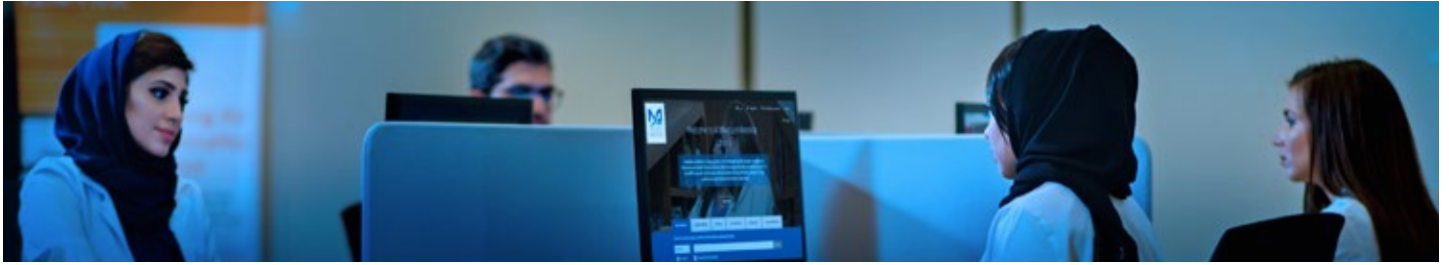
To register, complete all fields and then click **Submit Registration** and **Accept License**

Please use your organization email address when registering. Make sure your name is as you would like it reflected in your CME certificate.



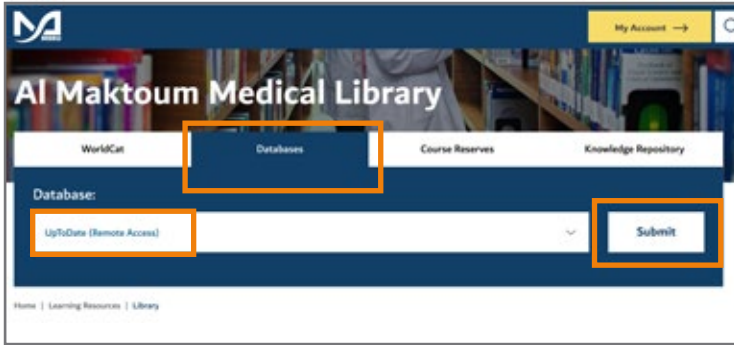
- 5 Test your automatic log-in to UpToDate from Salama by logging out of UpToDate, go back to Salama, click UpToDate button to test your automatic log-in.

Your personalized UpToDate homepage should load.



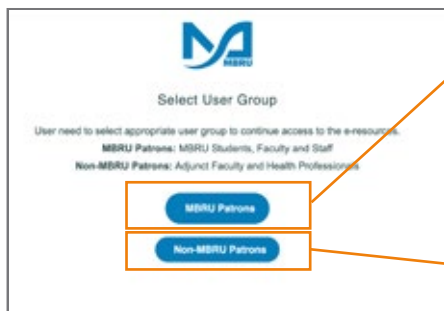
In addition to Salama, UpToDate can be accessed via the MBRU library website and Mobile App. Please refer to the below guide.

How to access UpToDate via Library



- 1 Go to the Library's website mbru.ac.ae/library
- 2 Click on the "Databases" tab, then select "UpToDate Remote Access" from the drop down menu and click the **Submit** button.

3 Login using your library credentials



Option 1

If you are a full-time MBRU member with an MBRU email, go to the "MBRU Patrons" tab and sign in with your university email and password.

For example;

Username: (firstname.lastname@mbru.ac.ae)

Password: (your MBRU email password)

Option 2

If you do not have an MBRU email address, go to the "Non-MBRU Patrons" tab and sign in using your registered email address and password.

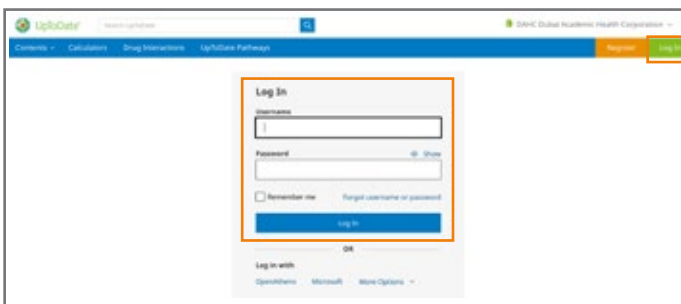
For example;

Username: johnsmith@gmail.com (your email provided for the library registration)

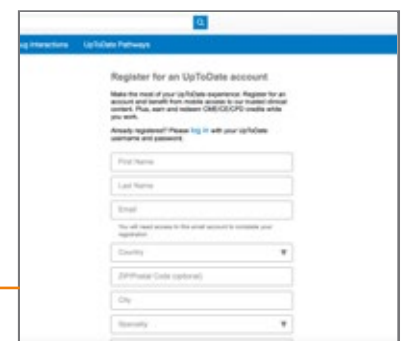
Password: (your password)



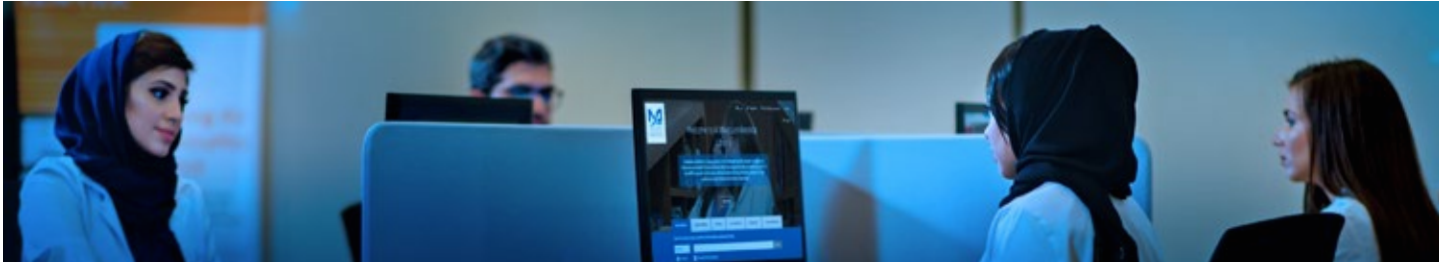
If you do not remember your password, you may click on "**SET/RESET PASSWORD**" option to reset your password



4 Login using your UpToDate credentials



- 5 If you do not have existing login credentials, click the Register button to create an account.



UpToDate Mobile App

Once registered, you can install the Mobile App on up to two devices by following the instructions below:

- On your smartphone or tablet, search for “UpToDate” in your app store and install the free app.
- Open the UpToDate Mobile App upon completion of download.
- Log in with your UpToDate Username and Password. You only need to do this once - the app remembers your Username and Password.

Maintaining UpToDate Access

Re-verification Method

- In order to maintain uninterrupted access to UpToDate Anywhere (remote access), you must re-verify your affiliation with your organization once every 90 days
- Re-verification can be accomplished via clicking on the UpToDate icon in Salama or accessing UpToDate through the library website (mbru.ac.ae/library)
- If you continue to log-in via Salama within 90-days period your account will never lapse remotely

Please note: In-application & email messaging will inform you of the need to verify affiliation if you have not done so by day 80. You will receive a second alert at day 90. If you fail to re-verify by day 90, you will lose mobile and remote access. To regain access, please complete the re-verification process outlined in “Reverification Method”

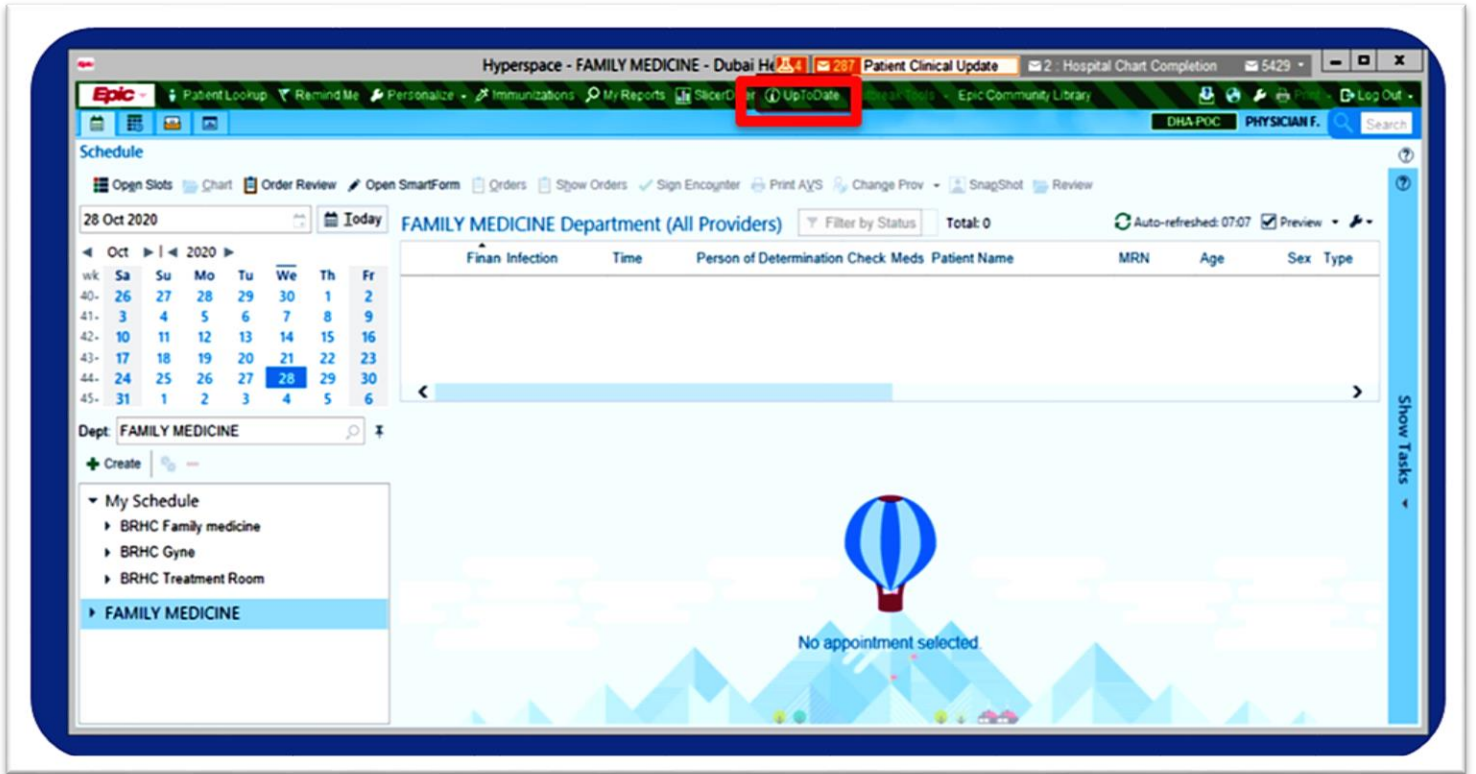

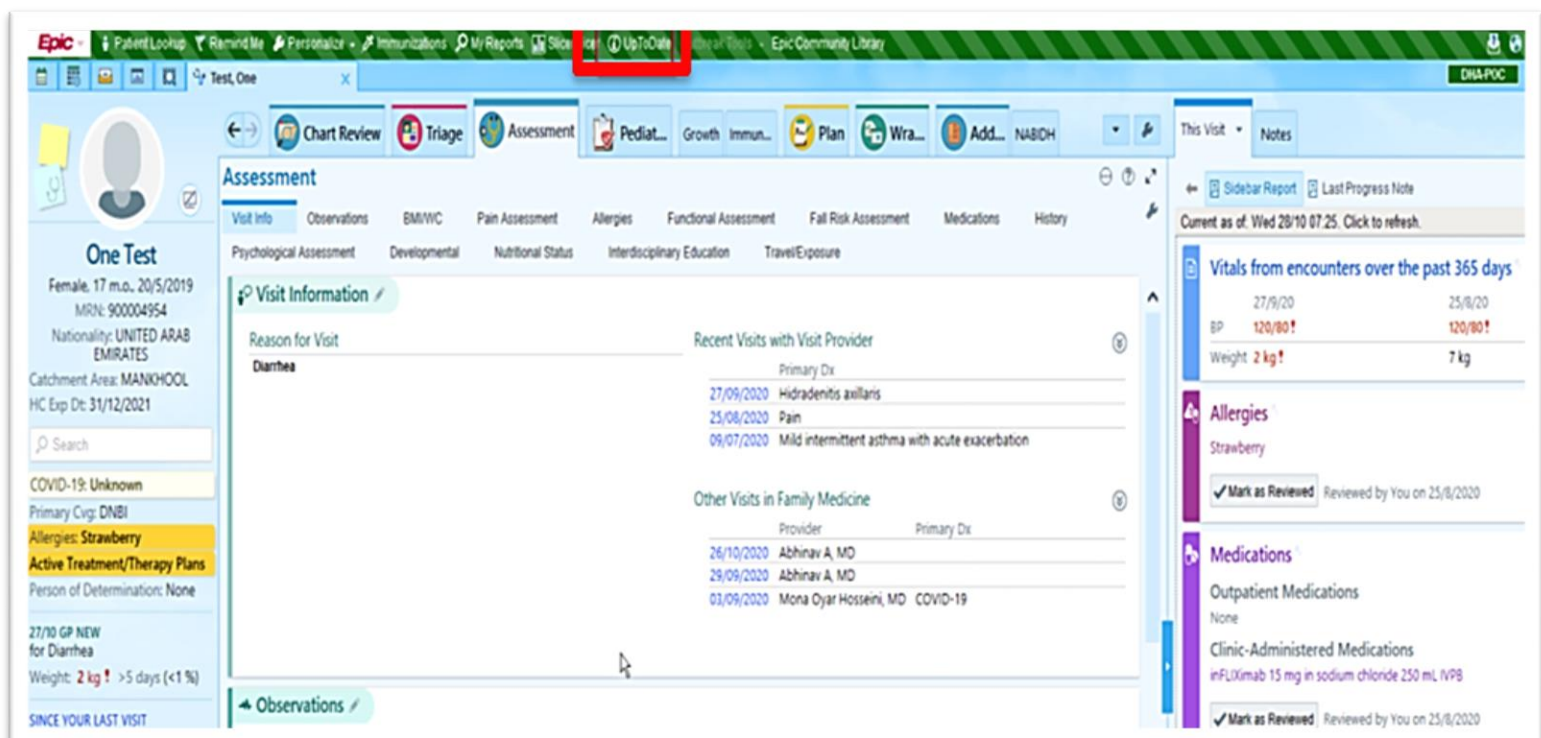

Schedule an Activity – Search UpToDate for patient visit preparations

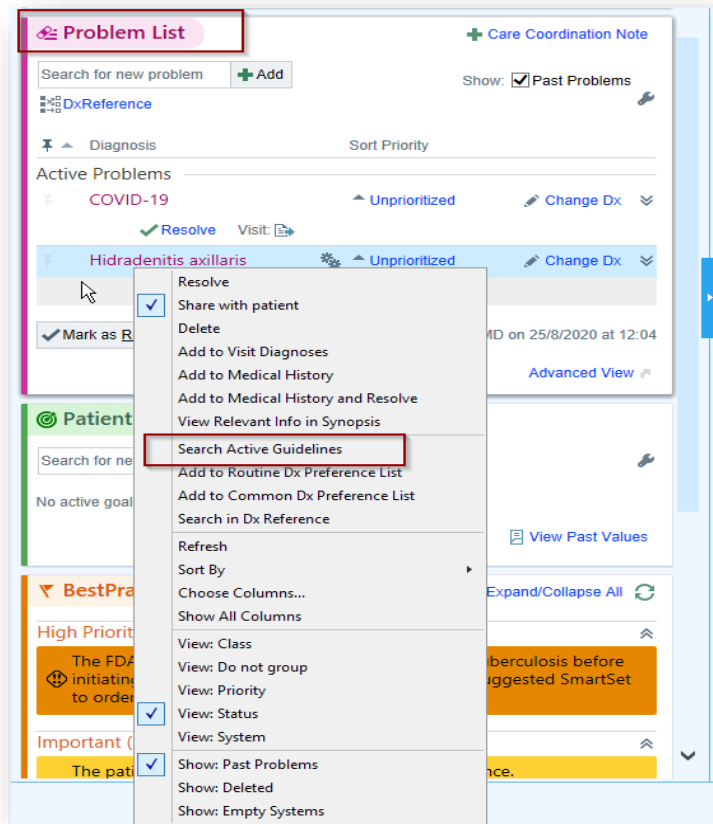
